MARCH 29 MUNICIPAL PRIMARY ELECTION REMINDERS

BATON ROUGE, La. — Secretary of State Nancy Landry reminds voters that Saturday, March 29 is Election Day for the Municipal Primary Election.

In preparation for the election, Secretary Landry encourages voters to remember:

- The deadline to register to vote in person, by mail, or at the OMV Office is Feb. 26.
- The deadline to register to vote through the <u>GeauxVote Online Registration System</u> is March 8.

- Early voting is March 15 22 (excluding Sunday, March 16) from 8:30 a.m. to 6 p.m. Early voting locations can be found at <u>voterportal.sos.la.gov/earlyvoting</u>.
- The deadline to request an absentee ballot is March 25 by 4:30 p.m. (other than military and overseas voters). Voters can request an absentee ballot online through the <u>Voter Portal</u> or in writing through the Registrar of Voters Office.
- The deadline for a voter to return a voted absentee ballot to their parish's <u>Registrar of Voters</u> Office is March 28 by 4:30 p.m. (other than military and overseas voters).
- Due to unpredictable mail delivery speeds, absentee voters utilizing the United States Postal Service are encouraged to allow additional time for their ballot to reach its destination.
- Polls open at 7 a.m. and close at 8 p.m. on Election Day. Anyone in line at 8 p.m. will be allowed to vote.
- Voters can find their polling location and sample ballot by downloading the GeauxVote Mobile app for smartphones, or by visiting <u>www.GeauxVote.com</u> and logging into the <u>Voter Portal</u>.
- Voters are encouraged to sign up for electronic notifications via GeauxVote Mobile.
- Voters should bring an ID with them to vote (Louisiana driver's license, Louisiana Special ID card, a generally recognized picture identification card with name and signature such as a passport, or a digital license via LA Wallet).
- Election results can be viewed in real-time via GeauxVote Mobile or at <u>www.sos.la.gov</u>.
