VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINES FOR THE MARCH 29 ELECTION

BATON ROUGE, La. — Secretary of State Nancy Landry reminds voters that the deadlines to register to vote in the March 29 Municipal Primary Election are quickly approaching. The deadline to register in person, by mail, or at the OMV Office is **Wednesday, Feb. 26**. The deadline to register through the <u>Geaux Vote Online Registration System</u> is **Saturday, March 8**. This deadline is for citizens who have never registered to vote, as well as voters who would like to make changes to their registration.

Citizens may check their registration or register to vote online at www.GeauxVote.com. After registering, voters should download the free GeauxVote Mobile smartphone app. The app provides registration information as well as voting districts, sample ballots, polling place information, and election results.

Early voting for the March 29 election will take place Saturday, March 15 through Saturday, March 22 (excluding Sunday, March 16) from 8:30 a.m. to 6 p.m.
